




Age of learner when started






Gender and ethnicity total (n=1011)






Family income (n = 1011)





Learning difficulty in family (n = 1011)






How did you hear about SPELD NZ?






What are the students' difficulties over the period from 2019-2022





Difficulty Handwriting 2019-22






Difficulty Spelling 2019-22






Difficulty in Written Expression (2019-2022)






Difficulty in Maths 2019-22






Lacking concentration 2019-22
